Blue Ribbon Challenge

The Blue Ribbon Challenge is taking place now until April 28th. The goal for this challenge is for the students to practice math and ELA concepts as well as test taking strategies that they can benifit from when taking the M-Step in April. Students earn blue ribbons on Study Island when they pass a topic with a minimum of 10 questions at 70% accuracy. I have instucted students to end the session right away if the questions are too hard and we can work through them together in class. If students continue answering questions wrong during a test, their accuracy level will go down causing them to answer a lot more questions. We call it "Digging a Hole", which is hard to get out of. If students are in a hole I can help them get out as I delete some of their prior tests that they did poorly on. The goal for this challenge is that students learn and practice academic skills, not get frustrated. Parents are encouraged to work through the problems with students as they can help talk through strategies with their child. Students can stay after on Mondays and Wednesdays until 4:30 during the months of February and March to work on earning blue ribbons for the Blue Ribbon Challenge. Please let me know if ahead of time if your child is planning on staying after.
