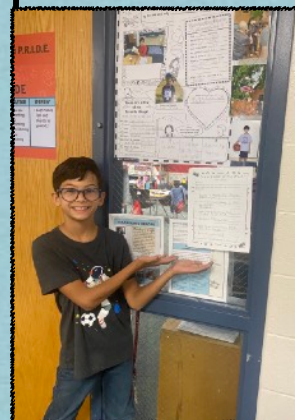


Constitution Day
