It looks like the weather will be nice this week, which means the first full week of school since our winter break!

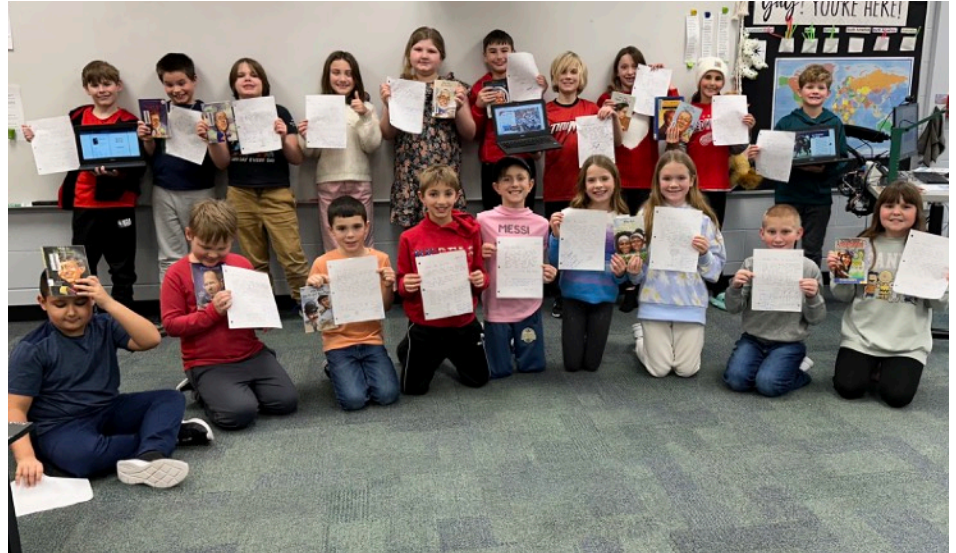
I am proud of all the students and the effort they put forth in last week's NWEA testing. Their results will be sent home with their report cards on Thursday.
